World Tuna Day: 02 May:-

The UN General Assembly voted in December 2016 to make World Tuna Day an annual observance. World Tuna Day was first celebrated in May 2017. The day was declared primarily to raise awareness about the importance of tuna fish and how their populations are dwindling as a result of unregulated fishing practices and poor conservation management. 


Alok Shukla Wins Prestigious Goldman Environmental Prize 2024:-

Alok Shukla, moderator of the Chhattisgarh Bachao Andolan and founding member of the Hasdeo Aranya Bachao Sangharsh Samiti, has been named the 2024 Goldman Prize from Asia, according to a release. The Goldman Environmental Foundation, which awards the prize, acknowledged that the Hasdeo movement's "ability to successfully influence policy has made it a model for environmental justice in India and generated an unprecedented amount of national and regional solidarity". Hasdeo, spanning 657 square miles, is one of India's largest contiguous forest areas.

RBI Proposes New Rules for Electronic Trading Platforms:

The Reserve Bank of India has recommended a revamped regulatory framework for Electronic Trading Platforms (ETPs) in response to greater integration of the onshore and offshore currency markets. Market makers have also asked the

Reserve Bank to provide access to offshore ETPs that sell Indian Rupee (INR) products. ETP refers to any electronic system, other than a recognized stock exchange, on which transactions in eligible instruments are executed. Eligible instruments mean securities, money market instruments, foreign exchange instruments, derivatives, or other instruments of like nature.

MEIL Wins 2,000 MW Sharavathi Pumped Storage Power Project :-

Megha Engineering and Infrastructure (MEIL), an Infrastructure firm announced the acquisition of a 2,000-megawatt Sharavathi pumped storage power project in Karnataka, which will cost Rs 8,000 crore. According to a corporate statement, the Sharavathi river is an important source of hydroelectric power in Karnataka, and with a planned total power output capacity of 2000 MW, it is the country's largest pump storage power generation plant. Karnataka aims to solve the power crisis in the state through this big budget project. The cost of the project is over Rs 8,000 crore, it stated.

Telecom Industry Seeks Ban on Illegal WiFi 6E Routers :-

The telecommunications industry organization COAI has sought a restriction on the sale of wifi 6E routers that use the 6 Ghz spectrum band for data transmission because the government has yet to decide on the usage of these frequencies. The Cellular Operators Association of India (COAI) claims that such routers are offered on e-commerce platforms such as Amazon, Flipkart, and Moglix, as well as by offline vendors. The COAI said the sale of equipment for 6 GHz band utilization, which has not yet been assigned for this purpose or has not been declared as licence-exempt by the government, is illegal and should be banned immediately in the country.
