

### 'Titanic', 'Lord of the Rings' actor Bernard Hill passes away :-

Bernard Hill, a British actor best known for his roles in Titanic and the Lord of the Rings trilogy, passed away recently. He was 79. Hill made his Lord of the Rings debut as Thoden, King of Rohan, in the trilogy's second film, The Two Towers, released in 2002. The next year, he reprised his role in Return of the King, which won 11 Oscars. Hill rose to prominence as Yosser Hughes in the 1982 British television drama "Boys From the Blackstuff," which followed five unemployed men. He was nominated for an award in 1983 from the British Academy of Film and Television Arts for the role, and the show won the BAFTA for best drama series.




#### IN-SPACe releases guidelines for implementation of Indian Space Policy 2023:-

The Indian National Space Promotion and Authorization Centre (IN-SPACe) has announced the norms, guidelines and procedures (NGP) for implementing the Indian Space Policy, 2023, in terms of space activity authorisation. "The NGP document lists space activities which need authorization from IN-SPACe, specifies criteria for granting such authorizations and provides necessary guidelines/pre-requisites to be fulfilled by an applicant for making authorization application to IN-SPACe," IN-SPACe said.

#### Thomas & Uber Cup 2024: China Secure Both Men's And Women's Crowns:-

The People's Republic of China reclaimed their position as the world's top badminton nation, winning both the men's and women's titles at the 2024 BWF Thomas & Uber Cup Finals in Chengdu recently. The hosts defeated Indonesia in the finals, making it the first time since 2012 that China won both the men's and women's global team titles. In the Thomas Cup, the Chinese denied Indonesia – the most successful nation in the history of the tournament – their 15th title to capture their 11th in the process.

#### India To Host 46th Antarctic Treaty Consultative Meeting In Kochi:-

The 46th Antarctic Treaty Consultative Meeting (ATCM 46) and the 26th Meeting of the Committee for Environmental Protection (CEP 26) will be held in Kochi, Kerala, from May 20 to 30, 2024, by the Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES) of the Government of India, through the National Centre for Polar and Ocean Research. This is consistent with India's ability to foster constructive global dialogue on environmental stewardship, scientific collaboration, and cooperation in Antarctica. The ATCM and meetings of the CEP are pivotal in the international community's ongoing efforts to safeguard Antarctica's fragile ecosystem and promote scientific research in the region.
