


DAILY UPDATE 1: IMPORTANT DAY

Primarily a Buddhist festival, the day is celebrated in most of South, Southeast and East Asia, including India, Sri Lanka, Nepal, Bhutan, Tibet, Thailand, Tibet, China, Korea, Laos, Vietnam, Mongolia, Cambodia, Indonesia, and more. This year, Buddha Jayanti falls on Thursday, May 23. This year marks the 2586th birth anniversary of Gautam Buddha.

RBI approves record dividend of Rs 2.11 lakh crore to government for FY24:-

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) approved a dividend of nearly Rs 2.11 lakh crore for the central government for the fiscal year 2024, marking a nearly 140% increase from the previous fiscal year. In FY23, the RBI had transferred Rs 87,416 crore to the Centre as surplus. During the 608th Meeting of the Central Board held in Mumbai, the board discussed the global and domestic economic scenarios, including potential risks to the outlook. The board ultimately decided to transfer a surplus of Rs 2,10,874 crore.



India Climbs To 39th Position In Travel & Tourism Development Index:-

India has climbed to the 39th position in the World Economic Forum's Travel & Tourism Development Index 2024, while US topped the list. India also ranks the highest in South Asia among the lower-middle-income economies. Earlier, India was ranked 54th in 2021 published index. On an overall index score of 7, where 1 is the worst, and 7 the best, India scored 4.25. India's significant leap in the rankings underscores its growing competitiveness in the global tourism landscape. The biennial index analyzed the travel and tourism sectors of 119 countries.

India's 4x400m mixed relay team wins gold at Asian Relay Championship:-

The Indian mixed 4x400m team of Muhammed Ajmal, Jyothika Sri Dandi, Amoj Jacob and Subha Venkatesan set a new national record to win the gold medal at the Asian Relay Championships 2024 in Bangkok, Thailand. The relay quartet stopped the clock at 3:14.12 in Bangkok. Team Sri Lanka clocked 3:17.00 to win the silver medal while the bronze went to Vietnam, who timed their run at 3:18.45. Despite the record-breaking effort, India is still not in the mix for a Paris 2024 Olympics quota in the mixed 4x400m event.
