International Day of Innocent Children Victims of Aggression: 04 June:-

Every year on June 4th, the International Day of Innocent Children Victims of Aggression is observed to highlight the suffering of children all over the world who have been subjected to physical, mental, and emotional abuse. The day affirms the United Nations' commitment to protecting children's rights. The war that began in June 1982, when Israeli Defense Forces invaded southern Lebanon, laid the groundwork for the day. On 19th August 1982, at its emergency special session, the General Assembly decided to commemorate 4 June as the International Day of Innocent Children Victims of Aggression every year.

Dinesh Karthik Announces Retirement From Representative Cricket :-

Dinesh Karthik, India and Tamil Nadu's wicketkeeper-batsman, has declared his retirement from competitive cricket. Karthik's final competition as a player was the Indian Premier League 2024, in which he represented Royal Challengers Bengaluru. The 39-year-old has played 94 ODIs, 60 T20Is, and 26 Tests for India, hitting 3,463 runs while also leading Tamil Nadu to many white-ball titles over the years. Veteran wicketkeeper-batter Dinesh Karthik cited mental challenges as the reason for stepping away from professional cricket, despite being physically fit to play for three more years.



India Endures Second-Hottest Year on Record in 2023:-

In 2023, India saw its second-hottest year on record, with unusually warm winters, monsoons, and post-monsoon seasons. At least 102 meteorological stations in 26 states and the Union Territories recorded their greatest monthly 24-hour maximum temperature in 122 years. Ten of these stations were in million-plus cities — Bengaluru, Jamshedpur, Kochi, Kota, Kozhikode, Lucknow, Madurai, Thiruvananthapuram, Thrissur and Visakhapatnam — showed the analysis in "State of India's Environment In Figures: 2024" by Down to Earth and Delhi-based think tank Centre for Science and Environment.

OpenAI Unveils ChatGPT Edu for Universities :-

Even while GPT-40 continues to astound the globe with its innovative powers, OpenAI has released yet another model, ChatGPT Edu. According to OpenAI, the new service features enterprise-level security and controls while remaining cheap for educational institutions. AICTE Comes Up With AI Certificate Course To Train Engineering Faculty Members :-

In Tamil Nadu, private colleges provide a variety of certification courses. As market demand grows, attempts have been made to offer additional courses in artificial intelligence and data science analytics. In this academic year 25 thousand seats are being added for engineering colleges to Anna University.

NASA, ESA To Develop Standardized Lunar Time System :-

NASA and the European Space Agency (ESA) are working together to develop a common time system for the moon as part of the Artemis mission, which intends to restore humans to the lunar surface. This new project will address the demand for a consistent timekeeping system to help coordinate missions from multiple countries and private organizations. With numerous lunar missions planned for the coming years, including those by China, India, and private companies, the lack of a standardized time zone on the moon poses logistical challenges.

Nishant Dev Becomes 1st Indian Male Boxer To Qualify For 2024 Paris Olympic Games :-

Nishant Dev, the bronze winner at the World Championships, became the first Indian male to qualify for the 2024 Paris Olympic Games after beating Moldova's Vasile Cebotari in a landslide 5-0 victory in the men's 71 kg category quarterfinal at the World Boxing Qualifiers. He will now become the fourth Indian pugilist to qualify for the Paris



Olympics after Nikhat Zareen (women's 50kg), Preeti (54kg), and Tokyo Olympics bronze medalist Lovlina Borgohain (75kg) confirmed their berths by winning bronze medals at the 2022 Asian Games.
