School Education Department Signs MoU With National Book Trust To Create Institutional Framework For Rashtriya E-Pustakalaya :-

In New Delhi, the Department of School Education signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the National Book Trust to establish an institutional framework for Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya, the Digital Library Platform. Speaking at the event, Secretary of the Department of Higher Education K. Sanjay Murthy stated that the Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya will be available throughout the time, regardless of the readers' geographic location, making books more accessible to them. He also added that the problem of last mile presence of a library for many states will be solved with Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya.




Mumbai's Super Cop Krishna Prakash Honored With Hindi Sahitya Bharati Award:-


Siddhalinga Pattanashetti Wins Gudleppa Hallikeri Award 2024 :-

PNB Board Approves 10% Stake Dilution In Canara HSBC Life Insurance Via IPO :-

Punjab National Bank (PNB) announced that its board of directors has approved the process of diluting a 10% share in Canara HSBC Life Insurance Company through an initial public offering (IPO). This new PNB move follows the Board of Canara Bank's consent to begin the process of diluting a 14.50 percent share in its subsidiary Canara HSBC Life Insurance. Currently, Canara Bank has a 51 per cent stake in the life insurer, while HSBC has a 26 per cent stake in the joint venture.

IIT Bombay, Delhi listed under top 150 in QS World University Ranking 2025 :-

IIT Bombay has secured the top rank in India in the most recent QS World University Rankings 2025, which were issued early Wednesday (June 5). According to the worldwide university rating agency, 61% of Indian universities have increased their rankings since the previous year. The Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) has retained its status as the greatest institute in the world for the 13th consecutive year. The Indian Institute of Technology Bombay (IIT-B) has risen from 149th in 2024 to 118th in the 2025 rankings, marking an improvement of 31 places. IIT Delhi advanced 47 positions, from 197 last year to 150 this year.

India Created World Record With 64.2 Crore People Voting In Lok Sabha Poll :-

According to Chief Election Commissioner Rajiv Kumar, India set a world record by having 64.2 crore voters, including 31.2 crore women, participate in the Lok Sabha elections this year. During a press briefing, he stated that the world's largest election process encompassed over 68,000 monitoring teams and 1.5 crore polling and security personnel. Mr Kumar stated that approximately four lakh vehicles, 135 special trains, and 1,692 air flights were employed to conduct the 2024 Lok Sabha election. "Only 39 repolls took place in the 2024 general elections as against 540 repolls in 2019," he said.

Ashok Leyland Rolls Out 'Sarathi Suraksha' Policy :-

Ashok Leyland, a heavy commercial vehicle manufacturer, has launched the 'Sarathi Suraksha' Policy to protect the driver community, which provides insurance coverage of up to Rs 10 lakh. The policy, known as a 'Unnamed GPA (Group Personal Accident) policy', covers any driver operating an Ashok Leyland vehicle and provides complete coverage. The comprehensive insurance policy covers accidental death, permanent and partial disability and also includes a special education bonus for children.

Haryana Government's Rs 10,000-Crore Project To Combat Air Pollution :-

Haryana Chief Secretary T V S N Prasad stated the state government will soon launch a Rs 10,000-crore World Bankfunded project to combat air pollution. The Haryana Clean Air Project for Sustainable Development will be implemented throughout the state in stages, with the first phase focusing on districts in the National Capital Region (NCR) and then expanding to the entire state, he stated. Underlining the significance of the project, Prasad emphasised the need of collective efforts by all stakeholders to eliminate the problem of air pollution.

Nvidia announces next-gen Rubin AI platform for 2026 :-

Nvidia Chief Executive Jensen Huang announced that the company's next-generation artificial intelligence (AI) chip platform, Rubin, would be released in 2026. Huang announced the Rubin chip family, which will comprise new graphics



(GPU), central processors (CPU), and networking chips, at National Taiwan University in Taipei as part of the Computex trade show. However, Huang offered few details. The new CPU will be called Versa and the new graphics chips that are used to power AI applications will bundle next generation high-bandwidth memory that is made by the likes of SK Hynix, Micron and Samsung.
