


### **DAILY UPDATE 1: IMPORTANT DAY**



#### World Food Safety Day: 07 June:-

Annually on June 7, the entire world commemorates World Food Safety Day to emphasize the need of upholding food standards. Every year, 4,20,000 people die worldwide as a result of illnesses caused by tainted food, according to the World Health Organization. The current increase in such diseases from food is due to a lack of purity and increased usage of chemicals (Toxic substance). Another major problem is the contamination of water as well. 


### Rakesh Mohan Joshi Appointed As Vice-Chancellor Of IIFT:-


**Book on Olive Ridleys released:-**




#### NOTA Creates Record In MP's Indore Lok Sabha Seat :-

Shankar Lalwani, the BJP's sitting MP from Indore, won by a record margin of 11,75,092 votes in a fight in which NOTA set a record with 2.18 lakh voters voting for 'none of the above' in the Lok Sabha election. A BJP leader predicted that his victory margin is likely to be the largest in the country's electoral history. Union Minister Virendra Kumar won the Tikamgarh (SC) seat by 4,03,312 votes over his Congress challenger Pankaj Ahirwar. The Congress had received a jolt in the Indore Lok Sabha seat after its candidate Akshay Kanti Bam withdrew his nomination on April 29, the last date for the withdrawal of nominations.

#### Om Birla Becomes First Lok Sabha Speaker In 20 Years To Be Re-Elected As MP:-

On June 4, Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla won the Kota parliamentary seat by more than 41,139 votes, making him the first presiding officer to be re-elected to the Lower House in 20 years. The last Lok Sabha speaker to be re-elected to the Lower House was P A Sangma, who served as the 11th Lok Sabha's presiding officer from 1996 to 1998. Sangma, then a Congress member, was re-elected from Tura in Meghalaya in the 1998 Lok Sabha election. In 2024, Birla defeated Congress's Prahlad Gunjal to retain the Kota parliamentary seat.




### **SEBI Forms Committee To Review Clearing Corporations:**

SEBI, the financial market regulator, has constituted a committee to assess the ownership and economic structure of clearing organizations and recommend actions to guarantee that they perform as robust, independent, and unbiased risk managers. The ad hoc committee will be chaired by Usha Thorat, a former Deputy Governor of the Reserve Bank of India. The market regulator said given the substantial growth of Indian securities markets in recent years, clearing corporations as central risk management institutions are important.




#### **IIT Dharwad Unveils Innovative Fire Rescue Drone:**

A team of lecturers and students from the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Dharwad, lead by Sudheer Siddapureddy and Ameer Mulla, created a fire rescue helper drone. The project was funded by TiHAN Foundation, IIT Hyderabad (NMICPS, Government of India). The fire rescue assistant drone was unveiled and shown during the two-day Drone Design and Autonomous Navigation in Fire Rescue (DDANFR 2024) workshop at IIT Dharwad. The event was organised by the Fire and Thermal Research Laboratory (FTRL) and the Control Systems and Robotics Laboratory.

### India To Host 81st IATA Annual General Meeting In 2025:-

After a 42-year break, India will host the world's largest aviation event, the International Air Transport Association's (IATA) annual general meeting (AGM) next year. This will be the third time the IATA AGM – one of the most important events on the aviation industry calendar — has been held in Delhi, following 1958 and 1983. The chiefs and various
