#### **India, S. Korea, US, Japan, EU Launch Biopharmaceutical Alliance :-**

South Korea, India, the United States, Japan, and the European Union (EU) have formed an alliance to collaborate on the development of an efficient supply chain in the biopharmaceutical sector, the South Korean presidential office said in Seoul. The Biopharmaceutical Alliance's inaugural conference, held in San Diego at the Bio International Convention 2024, featured representatives from participating countries' governments as well as bio and pharmaceutical enterprises. The alliance was launched in response to the drug supply shortages experienced during the Covid-19 pandemic.

### **Rajaji Raghathi Biosphere: India's first private biosphere :-**

The Rajaji Tiger Reserve (RTR) is planning to open its first private forest biosphere. The program, which was launched with the participation of Uttarakhand forest minister Subodh Uniyal, covers 35 acres of agricultural land in Baddiwala, on the southern side of RTR, which is home to a large elephant population as well as leopards, tigers, and ungulates. The brainchild of Delhi-based environmentalist Jai Dhar Gupta, founding member of the citizens' movement, 'My Right to Breathe', Rajaji Raghathi Biosphere (RRB), as the project is called, intends to provide an additional buffer forest to Rajaji.

### **Narendra Modi took oath for the third time as the Prime Minister of India :-**

Prime Minister Narendra Modi and the members of his new cabinet took their oaths on June 9. He is the first three-term Prime Minister since Congress icon Jawaharlal Nehru. The new cabinet decisions were made following a lengthy 11-hour meeting at the Prime Minister's house on June 8. The swearing-in event was held at Rashtrapati Bhawan in Delhi. The swearing-in ceremony witnessed the presence of leaders from neighbouring countries, including Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Bhutan, Nepal, Mauritius, and Seychelles, in addition to the Maldives, as part of India's 'Neighbourhood First' policy.

### **Ramoji Rao, Founder Of Eenadu Group & Ramoji Film City, Dies At 88 :-**

Ch Ramoji Rao, 88, a media figure and chairman of the Ramoji Group, died in a hospital in Hyderabad. Rao was best known as the CEO of the Ramoji Group, which includes Ramoji Film City, the world's largest film production facility, Eenadu daily, the ETV Network of TV networks, and the film production business Usha Kiram Movies. As a businessman, film producer and media entrepreneur, Rao was honoured with the Padma Vibhushan, India's second-highest civilian honour, for his contribution to literature, education and journalism.

### **Sarabjot Singh Shines At ISSF World Cup In Munich :-**

Sarabjot Singh captured the gold medal in the men's 10m Air Pistol event at the ISSF World Cup in Munich. The Indian shooter concluded with 242.7 points, narrowly defeating Shuaihang Bu of China, who claimed silver with 242.5 points. Robin Walter of Germany won the bronze medal with 220.0 points. This is India's first medal at the ISSF World Cup in Munich, and it serves as a huge morale boost ahead of the Paris Olympics in July. Sarabjot had qualified for the finals with 588 points to take the top spot. In the process he became the third Indian to make the medal rounds at the World Cup, after Ramita and Esha Singh had finished sixth in earlier event finals in Air Rifle and Air Pistol.

### **TDP President N. Chandrababu Naidu Set To Reclaim Andhra Pradesh CM Office :-**

Nara Chandrababu Naidu is expected to become Andhra Pradesh's Chief Minister for the fourth time in three decades. During his first nine-year term, from 1995 to 2004, Naidu established himself as the CEO of undivided Andhra Pradesh, transforming its economy, attracting investors, and constructing the IT zone in the capital city known as 'Cyberabad'. He spent the next decade in opposition while his political opponent and fellow, Y.S. Rajasekhara Reddy, took the reins after capitalizing on public outrage. By the time Naidu came back in 2014, the state was divided with the formation of Telangana.
