


World Sickle Cell Awareness Day : 19 June :-

Every year on June 19th, World Sickle Cell Awareness Day raises awareness about sickle cell disease (SCD) and its impact on individuals, families, and communities around the world. Sickle cell disease is a genetic blood ailment characterized by defective red blood cells that form a crescent or sickle shape. These irregularly shaped cells can cause blockages in blood arteries, resulting in a variety of health consequences. On December 22, 2008, the United Nations General Assembly passed a resolution declaring World Sickle Cell Awareness Day. The resolution recognised sickle cell disease as a global health concern and designated June 19th as the official day to raise awareness about the disease worldwide. This year's global theme is "Hope Through Progress: Advancing Care Globally."

World Sauntering Day : 19 June :-

Every year on June 19, World Sauntering Day is observed to celebrate life as it comes and not be concerned with the speed of the world; instead, we establish our own pace and enjoy it. Sauntering also helps to boost productivity and improve overall mood. The French coined the term saunter, which meant to walk casually and deliberately as if you had unlimited time. In 1970, W.T. Rabe, a publicist who worked at the Grand Hotel on Mackinac Island conceived this idea to combat the fact pace with which United States moved. Since 1970, World Sauntering Day is celebrated.

MEA And SBI Sign MoU To Enhance Digital Payments For Migrant Workers Via EMigrate Portal :-

The Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) and the State Bank of India (SBI) have inked a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for combining SBIePay, the payment gateway, with the eMigrate platform. Officials claimed that this connection will provide an extra digital payment facility to Indian migrant laborers, recruiting agents, and other portal users. The



agreement aims to "further facilitate and enhance the ambit of safe and legal migration of Indian migrant workers," according to a statement issued by the MEA.

DAILY UPDATE 4 : APPOINTMENT



Tesam Pongte Elected As The New Speaker Of Arunachal Pradesh Assembly :-



Tesam Pongte was unanimously elected Speaker of the Eighth Arunachal Pradesh Assembly. Pongte, who got elected from the Changlang North Assembly segment in the April 19 elections, informed the House that he would attempt to run the House impartially and provide all members an equal opportunity to participate in discussions and deliberations, regardless of political affiliation. BJP's Kardo Nyigyor was also elected uncontested as the Deputy Speaker of the House. Pongte was the Deputy Speaker in the previous Legislative Assembly.






Israeli Navy Receives Second Of New US-Built Landing Craft :-

The INS Komemiyut (Israel Navy Ship Independence) LSV (landing craft) has arrived in Israel and will be operationally integrated with the Israeli Navy. The ship arrived at the Israeli Navy Base in Haifa after departing from the port of Pascagoula in the United States. It is the second naval landing boat bought by the Israel Navy from the United States in the last eight months. The vessel's entrance to the State of Israel's territorial waters was accompanied by Israeli Navy vessels in a "missing" formation, this in memory of the fallen soldiers from the "Swords of Iron" war.

RBI Cancels Purvanchal Cooperative Bank's Licence:-

The Reserve Bank has revoked the licence of Purvanchal Co-operative Bank in Ghazipur, Uttar Pradesh, due to a lack of adequate capital and earning potential. The Commissioner for Cooperation and Registrar of Cooperative Societies in Uttar Pradesh has also been ordered to issue an order to wind up the bank and appoint a liquidator, according to the RBI statement. On liquidation, every depositor would be entitled to receive deposit insurance claim amount of his/her deposits up to Rs 5 lakh only from Deposit Insurance and Credit Guarantee Corporation (DICGC).

RBI Penalizes Central Bank Of India And Sonali Bank PLC For Violations :-

The RBI issued penalties of Rs 1.5 crore and Rs 9.4 lakh on the Central Bank of India and Bangladesh's Sonali Bank, respectively. The penalty imposed on the Central Bank is for failing to comply with RBI regulations on loans and advances, as well as client safety in electronic transactions. Sonali Bank was fined for failing to implement periodic risk categorisation reviews, use robust software for transaction alerts inconsistent with risk categorisation, comply with Swift-related operational controls, and become a member of all credit information companies within the specified timelines.

Chenab Bridge: Indian Railways Conducts Trial Run On World's Highest Steel Arch Rail Bridge :-

The Indian Railway Ministry has completed an electric engine testing from Sangaldan to Reasi. The testing included crossing Chenab, the world's highest steel arch rail bridge. The much-anticipated world's tallest railway bridge, purportedly 35 meters taller than Paris' Eiffel Tower, spans the Chenab River at a height of 359 metres. Northern Railway's Chief Public Relations Officer Deepak Kumar has scheduled the inspection for June 27 and 28. Kumar said that all necessary activities will be performed in time for the Commissioner of Railways Safety (CRS) inspection.




Indian Railways Enter Its Name Into Limca Book Of Records :-

The Ministry of Railways has made it into the "Limca Book of Records" for "most people at a public-service event - multiple venues." On February 26, 2024, the Railways Ministry organized an event that drew 40,19,516 individuals to 2,140 places. Prime Minister Narendra Modi hosted the event to inaugurate road over/under railway bridges and lay the foundation stones for railway stations. The mammoth effort and mobilisation of Indian Railways have been recognised, and the same has entered the prestigious Limca Book of World Records.

Lee Zii Jia Triumphs At BWF Australian Open 2024 :-

Malaysian Lee Zii Jia defeated Japan's Kodai Naraoka in the men's singles final to become Australian Open badminton champion, while Aya Ohori of Japan won the women's title. With several of the top players missing the competition, World No. 8 Lee took advantage, defeating his sixth-ranked opponent 21-19, 11-21, 21-18 in Sydney. It was his sixth



career win on the BWF World Tour, following his success at the Thailand Open last month. Ohori triumphed with a gutsy 17-21, 21-19, 21-16 comeback beating 35th-ranked Indonesian teenager Ester Nurumi Tri Wardoyo.
