### United Nations Public Service Day: 23 June:-

Every year, the UN Public Service Day recognizes the tremendous worth and noble nature of public service. Commemorated on June 23, this particular celebration aims to highlight the critical contribution of public servants. On December 20, 2002, the United Nations General Assembly adopted resolution 57/277, officially designating June 23 as Public Service Day. In 2003, the United Nations established the UN Public Service Awards (UNPSA) program to raise awareness of this significant day and promote the importance of public service. The 2024 UN Public Service Forum and Awards Ceremony will take place in Incheon, Republic of Korea from 24 to 26 June 2024, under the theme 'Fostering Innovation amid Global Challenges: a Public Sector Perspective'.




#### International Widow's Day: 23 June:-

# Government Appoints Atul Kumar Chaudhary As Secretary Of Telecom Regulatory Authority Of India :-

The government has nominated Atul Kumar Chaudhary as the new Secretary of the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI), a position that became vacant following V Raghunandan's retirement on May 31. Chaudhary is a 1989-batch Indian Telecom Service (ITS) officer who is currently the Deputy Director General (DDG) of the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI). He has worked in various capacities in Personnel, HR, Administration, Licencing, Vigilance wing of BSNL and Department of Telecommunications (DoT).

### India, Sri Lanka Commission Maritime Rescue Centre To Boost Security Ties:-

Sri Lankan President Ranil Wickremesinghe and External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar unveiled a virtual plaque commemorating the formal opening of the Maritime Rescue Coordination Centre (MRCC) in Sri Lanka. The centre will be created with a \$6 million contribution from India as part of attempts to strengthen maritime security partnerships in New Delhi's southern region. Wickremesinghe was among the seven top leaders from India's neighbourhood and the Indian Ocean region who attended the swearing in ceremony of PM Modi on June 9.

### Indian Deposits In Swiss Banks Drop By 70% To Reach Four-Year Low Of ₹9,771 Crore :-

In 2023, funds deposited by Indian individuals and corporations in Swiss banks, including local branches and other financial institutions, plummeted drastically by 70% to a four-year low of 1.04 billion Swiss Francs (₹9,771 crore), according to yearly figures from Switzerland's central bank. After reaching a 14-year high of CHF 3.83 billion in 2021, aggregate funds held by Indian clients with Swiss banks fell for the second year in a row, owing mostly to a steep drop in money held through bonds, securities, and various other financial instruments.

### DGCA issues advisory to increase women's representation in aviation sector:-

The Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has released an advising circular on 'Gender Equality in the Civil Aviation Sector' to aviation stakeholders. The Circular is published in accordance with the ideal of gender equality inherent in India's Constitution, as well as the International Civil Aviation Organization's aim of fostering equal



opportunities to achieve gender equality in aviation. The Circular aims to increase the number of women in various positions to a desirable representation of 25 per cent by 2025 within the aviation industry in India.
