International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking: 26 June:-

The International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking, commonly known as World Drug Day, is observed on June 26 every year. The day strives to increase action and cooperation in the pursuit of a drug-free world. According to the United Nations, by resolution 42/112 on December 7, 1987, the General Assembly declared June 26 as International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking as a reflection of its commitment to strengthen action and cooperation to achieve the goal of a drug-free world. The theme for 2024 is "The evidence is clear: invest in prevention".

International Day in Support of Victims of Torture: 26 June:-

On December 12, 1997, the United Nations General Assembly adopted a resolution designating June 26 as the International Day in Support of Victims of Torture. Adopting the UN resolution was a critical step toward recognizing that torture and inhumane treatment should be universally prohibited. The day is marked to encourage nations, civic societies, and individuals around the world to show their support for torture victims and those being tortured. Incidentally, the first International Day in Support of Victims of Torture was observed in 1998, which marked the 50th anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

S&P Retains India FY25 GDP Growth Estimate At 6.8%:-

S&P Global Ratings has maintained its FY25 GDP prediction for India at 6.8 percent, citing high borrowing rates and a reduced fiscal boost dampening demand in non-agricultural industries. S&P upped China's GDP growth prediction to 4.8% from 4.6% in 2024, but predicted a sequential decline in the June quarter. The rating agency anticipates the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) to lower its policy rate to 6% in the current fiscal year from 6.5 percent currently. Additionally, it anticipates further cuts in the lending rate to 5.5 per cent and 5.25 per cent in 2025-26 and 2026-27, respectively.

Uttar Pradesh Leads India in Compressed Biogas Production:

Uttar Pradesh has the capacity to generate 24% of the country's compressed biogas (CBG), according to a report by the Delhi-based think tank Centre for Science and Environment (CSE). The experts pointed out that UP could potentially instal 1,000 CBG projects from the 5,000 plants envisioned nationwide under the Sustainable Alternative Towards Affordable Transportation scheme, tapping into just 20 per cent of its surplus feedstock. Despite these promising statistics, the sector faces significant challenges.

J.P Nadda Launches National STOP Diarrhoea Campaign 2024 :-

Union Minister of Health and Family Welfare Jagat Prakash Nadda launched the National STOP Diarrhea Campaign 2024 at a ceremony in New Delhi. He kicked off the campaign by handing out oral rehydration salts (ORS) and zinc tablets to children in the presence of Minister of State for Health Anupriya Patel and Patraprao Jadhav. The two-month promotion will begin on July 1 and run until August 31. The goal behind the STOP Diarrhoea Campaign is to attain zero child deaths due to childhood diarrhoea.

Indian Archers Triumph At Archery World Cup 2024 Stage 3:-

The Archery World Cup 2024 Stage 3 in Antalya, Turkey, ended recently, with Indian archers demonstrating their remarkable talents and winning many medals. This famous event, hosted by World Archer, saw India's team win four medals: one gold, one silver, and two bronze. Dhiraj Bommadevara, 22, emerged as India's outstanding performer,



winning two bronze medals in recurve events. Teaming up with Bhajan Kaur, Bommadevara secured second bronze in the mixed recurve event.
