


World MSME Day : 27 June :-

The United Nations General Assembly established World MSME Day on June 27 in 2017 to raise awareness about the importance of micro, small, and medium-sized enterprises in supporting inclusive and sustainable development around the world. Srinagar Named 4th Indian 'World Craft City' By World Craft Council :-

The World Crafts Council (WCC), a non-governmental organization dedicated to empowering artists and preserving craft traditions around the world, has designated Srinagar as a World Craft City (WCC). This is likely to reestablish Kashmir's centuries-old connections with craft centers in Central Asia and Iran. The renewed prominence for a city with over 4,000 years of written history has focused attention on a location that has produced masterpieces in various art fields, including shawls, carpets, papier mache, and so on. The craft scene witnessed a major change in the 14th Century, with the arrival of Persian and Central Asian preachers and artisans.

J.P. Nadda Appointed As Leader Of The House In Rajya Sabha:-

JP Nadda, the BJP national president and Union health minister, has been named the leader of the house in Rajya Sabha, succeeding party colleague Piyush Goyal, who was sworn in as a Lok Sabha MP after winning the Mumbai North



constituency in the recently ended general elections. Goyal was elected as a Rajya Sabha MP on July 5, 2010, and was appointed Leader of the House on July 14, 2021. He was elected as the Lok Sabha MP on June 4, and was sworn in the Lower House on June 24. JP Nadda was first elected to Rajya Sabha on April 3, 2012.

Bureau Of Indian Standards Introduces New Standards To Enhance EV Safety And Quality In India :-

The Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) issued two new rules to improve the safety of electric vehicles in the L, M, and N categories. L represents two-wheelers, whereas M and N represent four-wheelers and cargo trucks, respectively. These new sets of guidelines, known as IS 18590: 2024 and IS 18606: 2024, focus on the essential components of electric vehicles, buses, and trucks, particularly the powertrain (which comprises components such as the motor and transmission). These standards are crucial in driving the transition to a more sustainable, environmentally friendly, and efficient transportation system in the country.

Indian Army Opened Khalubar War Memorial To Tourists In Ladakh :-

The Indian Army has opened the Khalubar War Memorial in Ladakh to tourists in honor of the heroes of the Kargil War. This inauguration event was part of the 'Forever in Operations' Division's Pre-Kargil Vijay Diwas activities, as the country is set to mark the 25th anniversary of Kargil Vijay Diwas on July 26. Located in the iconic Aryan Valley, this memorial honors the valiant efforts and sacrifices of soldiers who struggled to retake the valley during the war. Khalubar, a serene valley near the border, became a focal point during the Kargil War when enemy forces captured it.

Rahul Gandhi appointed leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha :-

Congress party secretary KC Venugopal announced that Rahul Gandhi has been named Leader of the Opposition in the Lok Sabha. Venugopal stated that the decision on the other office bearers will be made later. Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge welcomed the decision, adding that in the 18th Lok Sabha, the House of the People will really reflect the aspirations of the last person standing, with Rahul Gandhi serving as their voice. Several leaders lauded and thanked Rahul Gandhi for accepting the position and hoped he would remain the voice of people in Parliament by raising their issues.

India Wins 11 Medals At The U-17 Asian Wrestling Championship 2024 :-

India finished their tournament at the Under-17 Asian Wrestling Championships in Amman, Jordan, on a high note. The young Indian contingent won a total of 11 medals, including four gold, two silver, and five bronze. Women wrestlers won all four gold medals. Dipanshi in 46 kg, Muskan in 53 kg, Rajnita in 61 kg, and Mansi Lather in 69 kg all made outstanding performances in their respective weight divisions to win the gold medal. Raja Bala had to settle for a silver in the 40 kg category, despite her valiant efforts. On the men's front, Samarth Gajanan Mhakave bagged a silver medal in the fiercely contested 55 kg category.

Rohit Sharma Becomes First Batter To Hit 200 Sixes In T20Is :-

Rohit Sharma became the first player in T20I history to hit 200 sixes during the T20 World Cup 2024 Super Eight Group 1 match against Australia at St. Lucia's Daren Sammy National Cricket Stadium. Rohit played 41 balls for 92 runs and smashed eight sixes in the innings, bringing his total to 203 maximums in the game's shortest version. During the innings, the Indian opener also became the second-highest six-hitter in T20 World Cup history, surpassing David Warner (40) and Jos Buttler (43). On that list, Rohit is second to only Chris Gayle's 63 sixes.

Haryana Govt Increases Reservation For OBC Category From 15% To 27% :-

Haryana Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini has announced a rise in the yearly income ceiling for creamy layers from Rs 6 lakh to Rs 8 lakh, claiming that it will bring "significant benefits" in employment for the OBC category. Saini was addressing attendees at the 'OBC Morcha Sarv Samaj Samrasta Sammelan' in Gurugram. The move comes months before the Haryana Assembly elections, which are expected to be place in October. The chief minister also announced

that the reservation for the backward classes in Group-A and Group-B posts, currently at 15 per cent, will be increased to 27 per cent, "in line with the Central government's policy".
