


USA Independence Day : 04 July :-

The Indian Army contingent is in Thailand for the 13th iteration of the India-Thailand Joint Military Exercise MAITREE. The drill is set to take place from July 1st to 15th, 2024, in Fort Vachiraprakan in Thailand's Tak province. The previous iteration of the same exercise took place in Umroi, Meghalaya, in September 2019. The Indian Army contingent of 76 personnel is led by a Battalion of the LADAKH SCOUTS, with support from other arms and services. The Royal Thailand Army contingent also comprises 76 personnel mainly from 1st Battalion, 14 Infantry Regiment of 4 Division.

New horned frog species discovered in Arunachal Pradesh :-

A new species of horned frog that lives in the jungle has been identified at Arunachal Pradesh's Tale Wildlife Sanctuary. The research findings were published in the most recent issue of India's Zoological Survey Records. A team of researchers from the Zoological Survey of India (ZSI) in Shillong made the finding in partnership with colleagues from ZSI Pune and ZSI Itanagar. The frog species has been named after the state's Apatani tribe – Xenophrys apatani. This discovery marks a significant addition to India's herpeto-faunal diversity.

BCCI Announces Rs. 125 Crore Award For T20 World Champions India :-

The Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) has announced a massive Rs. 125 crore prize money for the senior men's Indian team following their T20 World Cup 2024 victory over South Africa in Barbados. According to the International Cricket Council, India won the competition with a seven-run victory in the final, earning \$2.45 million (Rs. 20.42 crore), while South Africa finished second with \$1.28 million (Rs. 10.67 crore). Senior stars Rohit, Virat Kohli and Ravindra Jadeja also announced their retirements from the T20I format.

Hathras stampede: death toll rises to 121 :-

The dead toll from a stampede at a religious assembly in Uttar Pradesh's Hathras has increased to 121, a senior official said on July 3. The Office of the Relief Commissioner reports that 28 persons were hurt in the July 2nd event. According to the report, 19 of the total victims have yet to be identified. Devprakash Mathur, the event's organizer, has been charged under BNS Sections 105, 110, 126, 223, and 238 by the Uttar Pradesh police. In view of the accident, the district administration has issued helplines 05722227041 and 05722227042 for the help of the general public, the official X handle of District Magistrate Hathras said in a post.

International toy fair to begin on July 6 with over 100 foreign buyers :-

The four-day international toy exhibition, which begins on July 6 in the national capital, is expected to attract more than 300 domestic enterprises and over 100 foreign buyers from the United States, Germany, and other nations, according to a release. According to Toy Association of India senior vice-president Naresh Kumar Gautam, around 250 Indian businesses will showcase their items at the event, which will be held at Pragati Maidan here. Gautam said that the 15th Toy Biz International B2B Expo 2024 is the largest fair in South Asia.

International conference to be held in August to solve man-animal conflicts in Karnataka: Minister Eshwar Khandre :-

In response to an increase in man-animal conflict in Karnataka, forest, ecology, and environment minister Eshwar Khandre said that an international conference will be organized in August to address the problem. The minister blamed the surge in man-elephant conflict on a loss in forests and increased commercial activity in buffer zones. He stated that



Karnataka has the greatest elephant population in India, with 6,395 elephants and 263 tigers. The prevalence of weeds has further exacerbated these conflicts, he noted.
