


DAILY UPDATE 1: AGREEMENT



K-Space, VSSC Ink New MoU For Space-Tech Development :-

K-Space, the Kerala government's Space Park project, has signed a new Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre (VSSC). Under the new MoU, VSSC experts will serve on K-Space advisory panels, giving assistance for its development and contributing to the creation of a space-tech ecosystem. The State government and the VSSC had inked an MoU in August 2019, in the initial days of the Space Park project. The project remained a non-starter.

President Murmu confers 10 Kirti Chakras, 26 Shaurya Chakras:-

President Droupadi Murmu has awarded 10 Kirti Chakras, seven of which were posthumous, to members of the Army and paramilitary forces for exhibiting indomitable fortitude and outstanding valour in the line of duty. The Kirti Chakra is India's second highest peacetime gallantry award. President Murmu, the Supreme Commander of the Armed Forces, awarded 26 Shaurya Chakras, including seven posthumously, to armed forces, Central Armed Police Forces, and state/Union Territory police personnel during a defence investiture ceremony at Rashtrapati Bhavan, according to a statement from the defence ministry.

RBI Slaps ₹1.32 Crore Monetary Penalty On PNB :-

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) slapped a Rs 1.32 crore monetary penalty on Punjab National Bank (PNB) for violating loan and advance and Know Your Customer (KYC) regulations. According to the RBI's media statement, the bank approved working capital demand loans to two state government-owned firms against payments due from the government in the form of subsidies, refunds, or reimbursements. The Statutory Inspection for Supervisory Evaluation (ISE 2022) of the lender was conducted with reference to its financial position as of March 31, 2022.

Defence Minister Rajnath Singh announced that India's annual defense production reached a record high of ₹ 1.27 lakh crore in 2023-24, with the Make in India program reaching new benchmarks. The value of defence manufacturing in FY 2022-23 was Rs 1,08,684 crore. Welcoming the "encouraging development", Prime Minister Narendra Modi said, "Compliments to all those who have contributed to this feat. We are fully committed to nurturing a supportive environment to further enhance our capabilities and establish India as a leading global defence manufacturing hub".

The motorcycle will be available in Maharashtra and Gujarat first, followed by other locations, and may be reserved at licensed Bajaj dealerships or through the company's official website. Rajiv Bajaj, managing director of Bajaj Auto, launched the CNG-powered bike in the presence of Union Minister for Road Transport and Highways Nitin Gadkari in Pune. Bajaj Freedom 125 is equipped with a twin-tank setup - one for petrol and the other for CNG.




Kolkata, Kokrajhar, Jamshedpur & Shillong to host 133rd Durand Cup:-
