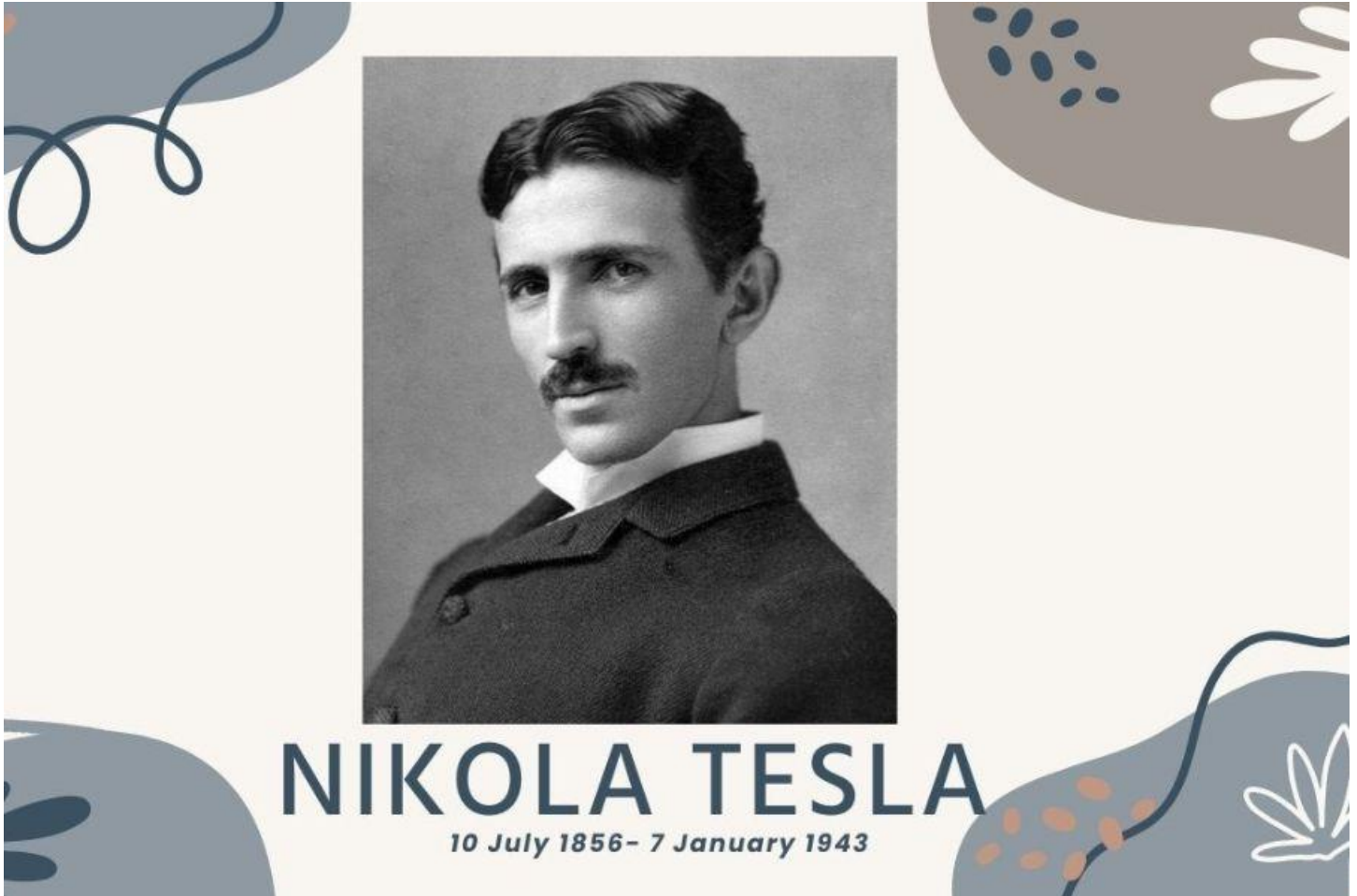
National Fish Farmers Day (India) : 10 July :-

India is preparing to conduct the famed Malabar naval drill in the Bay of Bengal this October, alongside the United States, Japan, and Australia. The move comes amid rising regional tensions, spurred by China's assertive operations in the South China Sea and its expanding influence across the Indian Ocean Region (IOR). The 28th edition of the Malabar exercise, with a major focus on advanced anti-submarine warfare, will be conducted on India's eastern seaboard in October to further enhance military interoperability among the four countries.

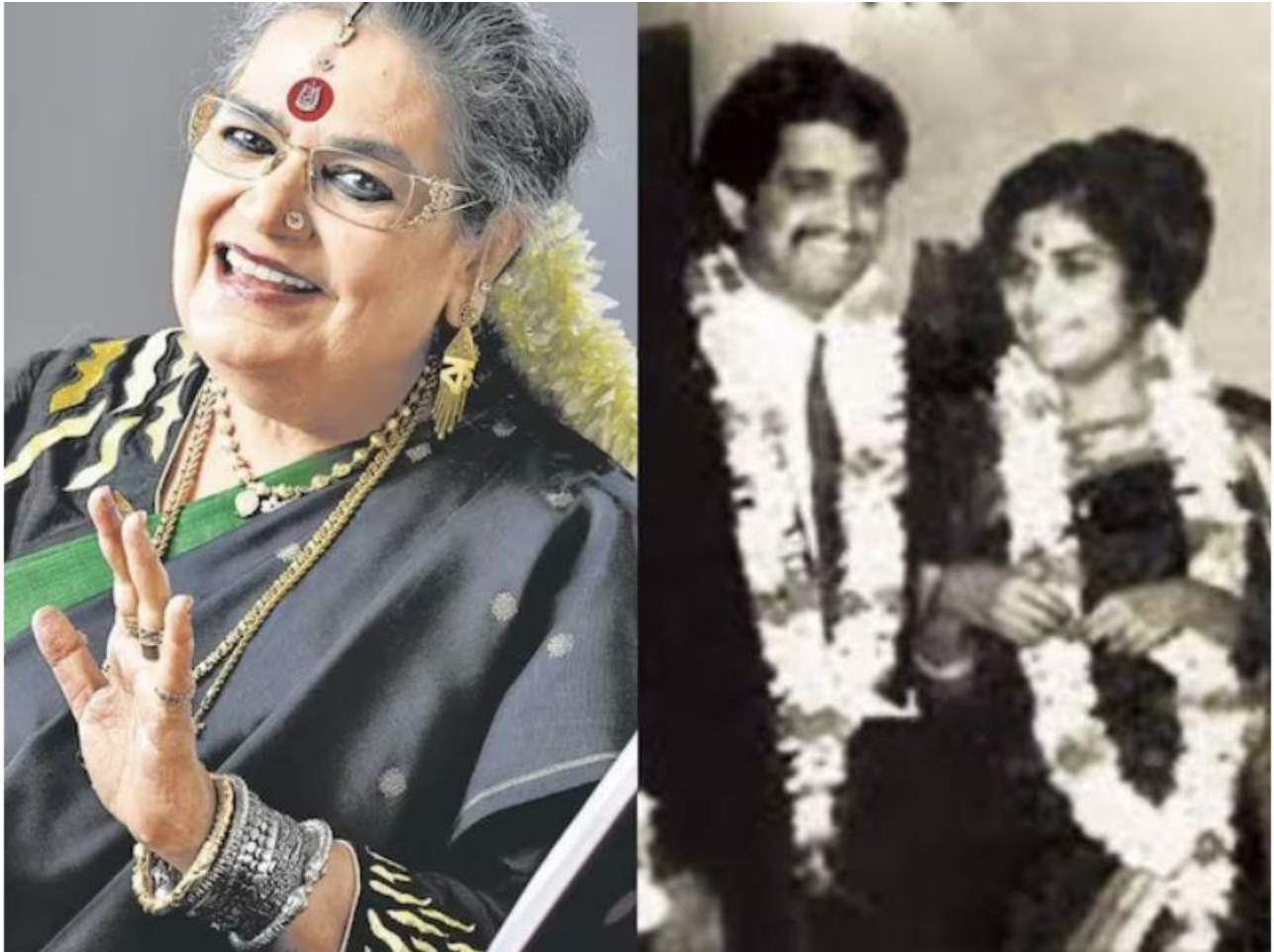
ICAI And MeitY Collaborate On AI Audit Tool For Corporate India :-

CA Institute President Ranjeet Kumar Agarwal announced that talks have begun with the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) to jointly build a 'AI Audit Tool' to track corporate India's performance and uncover corporate crime. Agarwal stated that the new tool will use artificial intelligence (AI) to coach and help enterprises in remaining 'going concerns'. After assuming charge as ICAI President, Agarwal had announced that CA Institute would during his Presidency focus on 'AI in ICAI'. The AI tool will be used to track performance of company, fraud reporting or any qualification.

Jani Chacko Uthup, the husband of Indian music icon Usha Uthup, died in Kolkata on July 8, according to his family. Jani, 78, complained of discomfort while watching television at their home. He was taken to a local hospital, but pronounced dead, according to reports. A major cardiac arrest caused the fatality, they noted. Jani, Usha's second husband, had a background in tea plantations. Earlier this year, Usha Uthup was honoured with the third-highest civilian award, Padma Bhushan, for her contribution to the field of the music industry.

RBI Report: India's Employment Growth At 6% In FY24 Vs 3.2% In FY23 :-

According to a Reserve Bank of India study, India provisionally created 46.7 million jobs in the fiscal year ending March 2024, bringing the overall number of people employed to 643.3 million. The country's employment growth rate was 6%

in that fiscal year, up from 3.2% the previous year, according to the RBI's report on assessing industry-level productivity and employment. The release of the data follows a Citibank report which said growth of close to 7% will only create 8 million to 9 million jobs in India, short of the 11 million to 12 million needed.

Indian Squash Players Triumph At Asian Squash Doubles Championship 2024 :-

Abhay Singh of India won two championships in the 2024 Asian Squash Doubles Championship, which was held at the Arena Emas in Johor, Malaysia. He won the mixed doubles title together with Joshna Chinappa, and the men's doubles title with Velavan Senthilkumar. Abhay Singh, who won gold in the Asian Games last year, joined up with Joshna Chinappa, a four-time World Doubles Championship medalist. They triumphed over Hong Kong China's Tong Tsz Wing and Ming Hong Tang with a score of 2-1 (11-8, 10-11, 11-5) to claim the mixed doubles title.
