


Vladimir Putin awards PM Modi Russia's highest civilian honour for 'outstanding service' :-

Prime Minister Narendra Modi received Russia's highest civilian decoration, the Order of Saint Andrew the Apostle. The Indian Prime Minister received Russia's highest civilian award in 2019 for "exceptional services in promoting special and privileged strategic partnership between Russia and India and friendly relations between the Russian and Indian people". It is bestowed upon prominent government officials, military leaders, and important personalities in science, culture, art, and many areas of the economy for their outstanding achievements to Russia.

Azerbaijan Army Participates In "Birlestik-2024" Joint Military Exercises In Kazakhstan :-

On July 8, Kazakhstan's Ministry of Defense disclosed the start of joint military exercises called 'Birlestik-2024' (Association-2024) by Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, and Uzbekistan in the country's Mangystau area.



Until July 17, the states' military contingents will simulate and practice a combined operation to localize an armed conflict in manoeuvres at the Oimasha training area and a Caspian Sea site two kilometers from Cape Tokmak. Some four thousand military personnel and up to 700 pieces of military equipment will be involved in the exercise.

BJP Kedarnath MLA Shaila Rani Rawat passes away at 68 :-

Shaila Rani Rawat, a BJP MLA from Kedarnath, died in a private hospital in Dehradun late on July 9 night. She was 68. Shaila Rani Rawat has been on ventilator support at the hospital for the past few days. She was undergoing treatment for a backbone injury. Shaila Rani Rawat won the Kedarnath seat on a Congress ticket in 2012, her maiden election to the Uttarakhand Assembly. She lost her seat in 2017, but won it again in 2022 on a BJP ticket. She was among the many Congress MLAs, who had rebelled against former chief minister Harish Rawat in 2016 and joined the BJP.

Uttar Pradesh Launches 'Mitra Van' Initiative Along Borders :-

The Yogi Adityanath government has announced the launch of 'Mitra Van' as part of the Vriksharopan Jan Abhiyan-2024 along Uttar Pradesh's border with Nepal. For this program, at least 35 forest divisions will find areas for the installation of 'Mitra Vans'. The Vriksharopan Jan Abhiyan-2024, which begins on July 20, is to conduct major tree planting drives in Uttar Pradesh's bordering districts. Thorough preparations are underway in all 35 districts bordering neighbouring states. Divisional forest officers (DFOs) have been instructed to expedite the establishment and enrichment of 'Mitra Van'.




Gagan Narang Appointed As India's Chef-De-Mission For Paris Olympics 2024 :-

Gagan Narang, a four-time Olympian and bronze medalist in the men's 10m Air Rifle at the 2012 Olympics, has been named Chef-de-Mission of the Indian presence for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games, which begin on July 26. Dr. PT Usha, President of the Indian Olympic Association, stated that the 41-year-old Gagan Narang's promotion from Deputy Chef-de-Mission was an obvious choice following Mary Kom's departure. Mary Kom, a bronze medalist in the 2012 Olympics announced that she would be stepping down from the role 'owing to personal reasons', in April 2024.


Gautam Gambhir Appointed Head Coach Of India Men's Team :-

Supreme Court Appoints Former CJI To Head VC Selection Committee In West Bengal :-

With the Mamata Banerjee-led TMC government and the West Bengal Governor at odds over the hiring of Vice-Chancellors for state-owned universities, the Supreme Court appointed former CJI U U Lalit as chairperson of the search-



and-selection committees tasked with shortlisting names for appointments. A bench of Justices Surya Kant and K V Viswanathan authorised the Chairman "to constitute separate or joint Search-cum-Selection Committees for one or more Universities, keeping in view the nature of subjects/disciplines in which education is being imparted in such pooled Universities".
