#### World Paper Bag Day: 12 July:-

World Paper Bag Day is a yearly celebration held on July 12 to raise awareness about the environmental benefits of utilizing paper bags instead of plastic bags. This day also honors Francis Wolle's creation of the first paper bag machine, which he created in 1852. He later secured a patent for the machine, and paper bags became the buzz of town. Paper bags are an excellent concept that has helped to alleviate the difficulties caused by plastic pollution. According to The World Counts, an estimated 100 million tonnes of plastic are used every year.

### Malala Day: 12 July:-

Malala Day is a yearly event celebrated on July 12th to honor Malala Yousafzai's persistence and advocacy. On July 12, 2013, the United Nations observed International Malala Day for the first time, a year after she was fatally shot by a Taliban gunman in Pakistan for criticizing the country's limitations on female education. Former British Prime Minister Gordon Brown, who served as UN Special Envoy for Global Education at the time, addressed the UN gathering. The day also coincides with Malala's birthday.




#### Rajat Sharma Elected As NBDA President :-




### Paediatrician Sanjay Wazir And Author Ambika Rikhye Launch Their Book 'Bundle Of Joy':

#### **Uttar Pradesh Defence Corridor Boosts Industrial Growth:**

The Uttar Pradesh (UP) government has inked over 150 defense manufacturing agreements for ₹25,000 crore (about \$3 billion USD). This plan fits with India's record-breaking annual defense production, which reached ₹1.27 trillion (\$15.4 billion USD) in fiscal year 2023-24, up 16.7% from the previous year. The defence projects are strategically located within the UP Defence Industrial Corridor (UPDIC), spanning six nodes across Lucknow, Kanpur, Jhansi, Aligarh, Chitrakoot, and Agra districts.




### PSU Banks Pay ₹6,481 Crore Dividend To Govt For FY 2023-24 :-

Four public sector banks, comprising Canara Bank and Indian Bank, handed over dividend checks totaling Rs 6,481 crore to Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman for fiscal year 2023-24. Similarly, Canara Bank MD and CEO K Satyanarayana Raju handed up a dividend check for Rs 1,838.15 crore. Indian Bank, situated in Chennai, issued a dividend of Rs 1,193.45 crore for fiscal year 2023-24. Bank of India also paid a dividend of Rs 935.44 crore, which was delivered by its MD and CEO, Rajneesh Karnatak. In addition, Mumbai-based financial institution EXIM Bank presented a dividend cheque of Rs 252 crore for 2023-24.

### **Europe's Ariane 6 Rocket Launched After 4-Year Delay:**

Europe's newest rocket, the Ariane 6, just completed its maiden voyage, putting satellites into orbit and restoring the continent's independent access to space. European space authorities praised the successful launch, keen to move on after recent setbacks, including a four-year delay in the development of Ariane 6. The Ariane 6 rocket, selected by the ESA in 2014, is capable of placing satellites in geostationary orbit 36,000 kilometres above Earth, as well as deploying satellite constellations at lower altitudes.
