


Colombo Security Conclave Welcomes Bangladesh As Fifth Member:-

The Colombo Security Conclave (CSC), a regional security organization, has officially welcomed Bangladesh as its fifth member state. The declaration was made during the 8th Deputy National Security Adviser (DNSA) level meeting, which was hosted digitally by Mauritius. The current members - India, Sri Lanka, Mauritius, and the Maldives - welcomed Bangladesh with open arms, while Seychelles served as an observer state. The Colombo Security Conclave was established in 2020, when India, Sri Lanka and the Maldives agreed to expand the scope of their trilateral meeting on maritime cooperation.




The Shining star Shelley Duvall has passed away at 75:-

Shelley Duvall, a veteran actress best known for her riveting appearances in Robert Altman's "3 Women" and Stanley Kubrick's "The Shining," died at the age of 75 from diabetes complications. Duvall's career was heavily influenced by filmmaker Robert Altman, who gave her first movie role in "Brewster McCloud." She then appeared in his films "McCabe & Mrs. Miller" and "Thieves Like Us" before making a substantial contribution to the ensemble cast of "Nashville" in 1975. Following her success in "Nashville," Altman cast her in "Buffalo Bill and the Indians" and later in "3 Women," where her distinctive screen presence earned her the Cannes Film Festival Award for Best Actress and a BAFTA nomination.

Sarus Crane Population Thrives In Uttar Pradesh:

The population of Sarus cranes in Uttar Pradesh is increasing, according to the most recent summer census, which was taken on June 20-21, 2024. It counted 19,918 Sarus cranes, up 396 from the previous year's tally, according to state forest department authorities. The Sarus is the official bird of the state. According to the survey, the Etawah Forest Division had the most Sarus cranes (3,289), an increase of 500, while the Mau Forest Division had six Sarus cranes for the first time in ten years. The summer census witnessed the participation of 10,000 citizens across U.P., for two days.
