Bastille Day or French National Day : 14 July :-

French National Day, often known as Bastille Day, is observed on July 14 every year. It commemorates the storming of the Bastille on July 14, 1789, a key event in the French Revolution. Bastille Day also commemorates the Fête de la Fédération, which occurred on July 14, 1790. The Fête de la Fédération was a celebration of togetherness held one year after the Bastille was stormed. More than 100,000 people attended the event, which included speeches, military parades, and fireworks. The name "Bastille Day" is actually mistermed. The French don't actually call it Bastille Day in French. The name is Fête du 14 juillet, which simply means "July 14 Celebration" according to the Library of Congress.

Indian Air Force contingent in Australia to participate in Exercise Pitch Back 2024 :-

The Indian Air Force (IAF) has sent a large detachment to take part in Exercise Pitch Black 2024 at the Royal Australian Air Force (RAAF) Base in Darwin, Australia. The exercise, which runs from July 12 to August 2, 2024, is a biennial global

event organized by the RAAF. This year's event is expected to be the largest in its 43-year history, with participation from 20 countries, over 140 aircraft, and around 4,435 military personnel. Exercise Pitch Black focuses on Large Force Employment (LFE) warfare, a concept that involves coordinating large numbers of aircraft in complex missions.

Kotak Mahindra Mutual Fund Launches BSE PSU Index Fund :-

The BSE PSU Index Fund, a passive equity plan that will mimic the BSE PSU Index, has been introduced by Kotak Mahindra AMC. Currently, 56 public sector undertaking (PSU) equities from various sectors are included in the index. Devender Singhal, Fund Manager at the AMC, said, "While individual PSU stocks may exhibit varying performance, this index-based approach allows investors to potentially benefit from the overall growth and reforms in the public sector. As India continues its economic trajectory, this fund offers investors a chance to be part of that journey through a comparatively cost-effective and systematically managed investment vehicle".

RBI Eases LRS Norms For Investment Via GIFT IFSC :-

The Reserve Bank of India has broadened the Liberalised Remittance Scheme (LRS) to include International Financial Services Centres (IFSCs). The apex bank permitted authorized individuals to facilitate transfers for the purpose of obtaining financial services or goods within IFSCs in accordance with the International Financial Services Centres Authority Act of 2019. It has also permitted current or capital account transactions overseas (except foreign IFSCs) through a foreign currency account (FCA). For these purposes, resident individuals can open an FCA at GIFT IFSC.

DRDO Seven New Projects Awarded To Industries Under Technology Development Fund Scheme :-

The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) has granted seven new projects to enterprises under the Technology Development Fund plan to meet the needs of the Armed Forces, aerospace, and defense sectors. The approved projects include the creation of ice detecting sensors for aircraft, underwater launched unmanned aerial vehicles, and long-range remotely operated vehicles for detection and neutralization. The Ministry said, the Indigenous development of these technologies will strengthen the military-industrial ecosystem.

Ireland Surpasses Mauritius In Preferred FPI Destinations :-

Mauritius, formerly a top destination for foreign portfolio investors (FPIs) routing funds into India, has slid to fifth place, after Ireland, in terms of assets under custody (AUC) as of June 30. Ireland ranked fourth with an AUC of Rs 4.41 trillion, slightly higher than Mauritius, which had an AUC of Rs 4.39 trillion at the end of June 2024, according to data from the National Securities Depository (NSDL). The gap between the two jurisdictions becomes more pronounced when examining pure equity holdings.


James Anderson Retires From Test Cricket :-

James Anderson's retirement from Test cricket for England marks the end of an era. The veteran sprinter has ended his storied 21-year career. Anderson has the most wickets of any fast bowler in Test history, with 704 in 188 appearances. Anderson's former compatriot Stuart Broad, who has already retired, is the only other pacer with more than 600 Test wickets, namely 604. Anderson retired with a record 188 Test appearances, the second-most for a player after Sachin Tendulkar, who played 200 Tests. Among the current active players, Australia's Nathan Lyon is the next in line with 129 Test appearances.

Second Phase Of Construction Begins On World's Largest Ramayan Temple In Bihar :-

The second phase of building on the "world's largest Ramayan temple" has recently begun in Bihar's East Champaran district. The Viraat Ramayan Mandir, once completed, will be three times the size of the Ram Mandir in Ayodhya. The temple, estimated to cost ₹500 crore, will feature the world's largest Shivaling. The temple's construction draws inspiration from Angkor Wat in Cambodia, the Ramanathaswamy temple at Rameswaram, Tamil Nadu, and the

Meenakshi Sundareswarar temple in Madurai. The construction of the three-storey temple, spread over an area of 3.76 lakh sq.ft., began in June 2023 and is expected to be complete in 2025.
