Government Appoints Robert J Ravi As New CMD Of BSNL :-

The government has selected top Department of Telecommunications (DoT) officer Robert J Ravi as Chairman and Managing Director (CMD) of Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL). The government has chosen not to prolong the term of P K Purwar. Purwar, who took over as BSNL CMD in July 2019 for a five-year term, had requested for an extension. Ravi A Robert Jerard, currently serving as Deputy Director General (SRI) at DoT, is CMD of MTNL, and CMD of BBNL. This additional charge of appointment as BSNL CMD will be effective from July 15, 2024 until January 14, 2025.

Jio Financial Services Gets RBI Nod To Become Core Investment Company :-

Jio Financial Services announced in a stock exchange filing that it has received approval from the Reserve Bank of India to transform from a non-bank financial company to a core investment company (CIC). Jio Financial, Reliance Industries Ltd's (RIL) financial services business, applied to become a CIC in November after the banking regulator ordered the conversion following its separation from RIL and a change in its shareholding structure. With the transition, Jio Financial Services could streamline its diverse business verticals—spanning lending, asset management, insurance, and more—into distinct entities under the CIC umbrella.

Government To Launch 'Agri Fund For Start-Ups & Rural Enterprises' :-

The government will soon initiate the 'Agri Fund for Start-Ups & Rural Enterprises' (AgriSURE) to assist start-ups and agripreneurs via investments in sector-specific, sector-agnostic, and debt Alternative Investment Funds (AIFs), as well as direct equity support to start-ups that operate in agriculture and related sectors. This program seeks to promote innovation and sustainability in India's agriculture industry by establishing a Rs 750 crore Category-II Alternative Investment Fund (AIF). The fund will offer both equity and debt support, specifically targeting high-risk, high- impact activities in the agriculture value chain.

Veteran trainer S.K. Sunderji passes away :-

Sheraz K. Sunderji, a veteran trainer, died following a heroic battle with cancer. He was 64 years old and had lately resigned his trainer's licence. Sunderji started his extraordinary horse training career in 1985. Over over four decades, he saddled over a thousand winners. One of his most cherished objectives was to win the renowned Indian Derby, which he accomplished in 2018 with his horse Rochester. He saddled his first Pune Derby through Desert Warrior (1989), followed by Desert Carnival (1995), Ocean And Beyond (2010) and most recently Trouville (2019).

India's Population To Peak At 1.7 Billion By 2060s Before Declining: UN Report :-

India's population is expected to peak at over 1.7 billion in the early 2060s before declining by 12%, but the country will remain the world's most populous throughout the century, according to the United Nations. According to the World Population Prospects 2024 report, the world's population is predicted to expand further during the next 50-60 years, peaking at roughly 10.3 billion people in the mid-2080s, up from 8.2 billion in 2024. After peaking, the global population is projected to start declining gradually, falling to 10.2 billion people by the end of the century.

Spain Clinches Euro 2024 Title With Dramatic Victory Over England :-

Spain won their fourth European Championship with a 2-1 victory over England in a thrilling final. Mikel Oyarzabal's 87th-minute goal, assisted by Marc Cucurella, sealed the victory and dashed England's hopes of forcing extra time following Cole Palmer's 73rd-minute equalizer. Nico Williams scored the opening goal for Spain in the 47th minute, assisted by 17-year-old Lamine Yamal. The match in Berlin's Olympiastadion was attended by notable figures such as Prince William and Spain's King Felipe, underscoring its historical significance. Spain's emotional celebration highlighted their joyous triumph and united spirit with their fans.

India Champions Triumph In World Championship Of Legends 2024 :-

India Champions defeated Pakistan Champions by five wickets in the 2024 World Championship of Legends final played in Birmingham. India, led by Yuvraj Singh, successfully pursued a 157-run goal in 19.1 overs. Ambati Rayudu set the tone with a quickfire fifty, followed by important contributions from Yusuf Pathan, Gurkeerat Singh Mann, and the skipper himself. Pakistan, opting to bat first, posted a total of 156 for 6. Indian bowlers, spearheaded by Anureet Singh's three-wicket haul, effectively restricted Pakistan's run flow.
