


DAILY UPDATE 1: IMPORTANT DAY



APJ Abdul Kalam's Death Anniversary: 27 July:-

Former President of India APJ Abdul Kalam, also known as the 'Missile Man of India' and the 'People's President,' died on this day in 2015 at the age of 83 while giving a lecture at the Indian Institute of Management-Shillong. APJ Abdul Kalam's full name is Avul Pakir Jainulabdeen. He was the eleventh president of India. This year marks the tenth anniversary of his death. He played an important role in India's 1998 nuclear test, which was led by Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee. From 2002 to 2007, he served as the 11th president of India.






CRPF Raising Day: 27 July:-

The Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) inaugural day is observed on July 27 each year to mark the founding of the central force on this date in 1939. The CRPF is an important aspect of India's internal security and one of the oldest Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF). Founded in 1939 as the Crown Representative Police, the CRPF was India's internal combat force. On December 28, 1949, Parliament approved an Act renaming the force the CRPF. The CRPF aided the Indian Army during the 1962 battle with China in Arunachal Pradesh. The force played a key role in establishing peace in the northeastern part of the country. The force also assisted the army in the 1965 and 1971 Indo-Pak wars.

Ashwini Vaishnaw, Union Minister of Information and Broadcasting (I&B), declared the recipients of the 10th National Community Radio Awards. Indian Army Departs For Multinational Exercise KHAAN QUEST 2024:-

The Indian Army contingent left for the Multinational Military Exercise 'Khaan Quest' on July 25. The exercise is set to take place in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia, from July 27 to August 9, 2024, and will bring together armed units from around the world to work and improve their peacekeeping capabilities. The last version of Exercise 'Khaan Quest' took place in Mongolia from June 19 to July 2, 2023. The exercise began as a bilateral event between the United States and the Mongolian Armed Forces in 2003. From 2006 onwards, it evolved into a multinational peacekeeping exercise, with this year marking the 21st iteration.




Ministry Of Steel Launches 'Steel Import Monitoring System' 2.0 Portal:-

Shri H.D. Kumaraswamy, Union Minister for Steel and Heavy Industries, unveiled SIMS 2.0, an enhanced Steel Import Monitoring System. SIMS, which was launched in 2019, has played an important role in supplying detailed steel import statistics to the domestic industry. Based on industry comments, the Ministry has updated the portal to create a more effective SIMS 2.0, which represents a big step forward in monitoring steel imports and boosting domestic steel production. Availability of such detailed data not only provides input for policy making but also signals areas for production and growth to the domestic steel industry.

Lithium deposits found in Karnataka's Mandya and Yadgiri districts, Minister Jitendra Singh announces:-

Jitendra Singh, Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Earth Sciences in the Rajya Sabha, announced the discovery of lithium resources in Karnataka's Mandya and Yadgiri districts. The minister noted in a written response that the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research (AMD), a constituent entity of the Department of Atomic Energy, discovered lithium resources in Karnataka's Mandya and Yadgiri districts. Singh shared that a preliminary survey carried out recently by AMD in Himachal Pradesh has led to the identification of surface uranium occurrence in Masanbal, Hamirpur district.

Nita Ambani Unanimously Re-Elected As IOCM: Paris Olympic, 2024:-

Ahead of the opening festivities of the Paris 2024 Olympic Games, the International Olympic Committee (IOC) declared that Nita Ambani, Founder of Reliance Foundation, was unanimously re-elected as India's IOC representative at the 142nd IOC session in Paris, receiving 100% of the vote. Nita Ambani was originally selected to the distinguished body in 2016, during the Rio de Janeiro Olympics. Since then, as India's first woman to join the IOC, Nita Ambani has already made great strides for the association, whilst also championing India's sporting ambitions and Olympic vision.

Rashtrapati Bhavan's Durbar Hall, Ashok Hall renamed:-

President Droupadi Murmu has declared the renaming of two halls of Rashtrapati Bhavan, 'Durbar Hall' and 'Ashok Hall', as 'Ganatantra Mandap' and 'Ashok Mandap', respectively. The Rashtrapati Bhavan was completed in 1929, after King George V decreed that the capital of British India will be relocated from Calcutta to Delhi in 1911. The hall conducts Civil and Defence Investiture Ceremonies, during which the President bestows honors on the recipients. Swearing-in ceremonies, like those of the Chief Justices of India, are also conducted here. Durbar Hall witnessed a historic moment in the swearing-in ceremony of independent India's first government in 1947.

India's Installed Nuclear Power Capacity To Triple By 2031-32:-

Dr. Jitendra Singh, Union Minister of State for the Department of Atomic Energy, stated in a written reply to an unstarred question in the Rajya Sabha that India's nuclear power capacity will expand from 8,180 megawatts to 22,480 megawatts by 2031-32. Singh emphasized India's commitment to reaching net zero emissions by 2070. "Various studies have projected the need for a national nuclear capacity of approximately 1,00,000 MW by 2047, and the recommendations from these studies are being considered for future adoption," he said.

2024 Paris Olympic Games Commenced :-

The Paris 2024 Olympics are officially kick stated on July 26, with an elaborate opening ceremony along the Seine River in France. However, the Games 'unofficially' began on July 24 with football and rugby sevens competitions, followed by women's handball and archery individual ranking rounds on July 25th. India's medal possibilities at the Paris Olympics include Neeraj Chopra, Satwik-Chirag, and Mirabai Chanu. India is being represented by 117 competitors in the 2024 Summer Olympics in Paris. Only the second Indian athlete to win an individual gold medal at the Summer Olympic Games, Neeraj Chopra is India's strongest contender going into Paris 2024.
