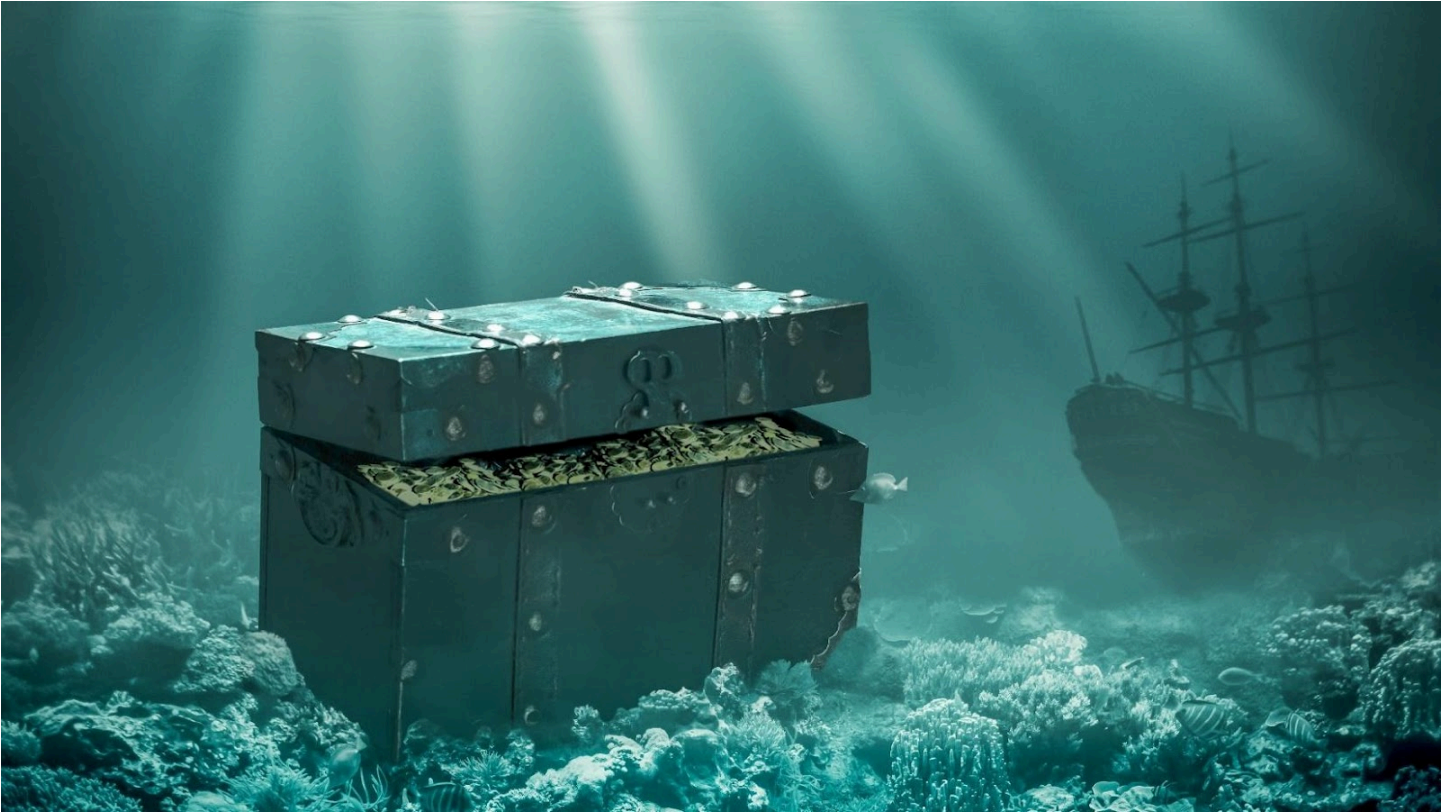
WHO Launches mRNA Vaccine Project for H5N1 Bird Flu :-
